Day 1

Overnight flight to Cape Town

Days 2 - 5

Arrive Cape Town International Airport and pick up your rental car (GROUP B (VW POLO 1.4 - 5-DOOR OR SIMILAR: MANUAL, AIR-CONDITIONER, CD, POWER STEERING), and self drive to your accommodation for a 3 night stay in a double en suite room on a bed and breakfast basis.

We select accommodation according to budget levels, but highly recommend some of the lovely boutique guesthouses which are well located and offer excellent hospitality.

Cape Town is a vibrant, cosmopolitan city offering outdoor activities, a lively music scene and a host of trendy bars and restaurants. Contrasts abound in this city, with beaches, vineyards, and of course Table Mountain within easy reach, and the stark differences between the townships and beach-side mansions providing a constant reminder of this nation's tumultuous history. We can provide advice on things to do, and include a factsheet with recommendations and useful information on Cape Town with all bookings.

Days 5 - 7

Today you take the relatively short drive to the Winelands.

The area has 3 main towns, each a bit different, but all probably worth exploring. The people in the area are extremely friendly and welcoming and more than happy to give advice on restaurants and wines. A day out visiting local vineyards – many of which include cellar tours and wine tastings – is a must: some of them offer lunch as you sip! The area is a gastronomic delight: many world class chefs have relocated to this area - we will be happy to recommend restaurants and vineyards to visit in the area.

You stay for 2 nights at a centrally located Boutique Hotel & Spa in a standard double room on a bed and breakfast basis. Set in two historical houses with 16 en suite rooms, this accommodation is ideally situated a few minutes' stroll to Stellenbosch's museums, restaurants, street cafes and galleries. Hearty breakfasts are served by the pool and there is a spa for treatments. Stellenbosch is a university town: the student population brings a liveliness to the town, with live music in the bars and cultural events: your guesthouse owners will be happy to advise on things happening on the evenings you are in town and make any bookings for you.

Days 7 - 10

Today, you return to Cape Town International Airport, where you drop off your hire vehicle and connect with your flight to Kruger International Airport. On arrival, you will be met and transferred by air conditioned vehicle to your Game Lodge for 3 nights in a standard chalet on a full board basis, including teas/coffees, two activities per day and bush walks.

Your game lodge consists of six chalets which offers the privacy and exclusivity of a real African bush experience. Each luxury suite is air-conditioned and architecturally designed offering modern comforts in an ancient setting, with a private wooden deck, lounge area and an outside shower. Meals are served on the dining deck high up in the tree canopy overlooking the river. Every third night you enjoy dinner in the bush, weather permitting.

Morning and afternoon game drives, in open game drive vehicles, take place in the Game Reserve with big five sightings regularly seen. African wild dogs have been re-introduced in the area. Hippos and crocodiles are regularly seen during bushwalks with an armed guide.

Day 10 - 12

Today, you transfer by air conditioned vehicle from your Game Lodge to Hoedspruit Airport for your flight to O R Tambo International Airport. You spend a few days with friends in Johannesburg

Days 12 - 17

Today you return to Johannesburg airport by courtesy shuttle bus for your onward flight to Mauritius. On arrival in Mauritius, you will be met and privately transferred to The Heritage Awali Resort & Spa, for 5 nights in a deluxe room on an all inclusive basis. The 5 star Heritage Golf Resort and Spa, is beautifully located in the mountainous South of the Island, surrounded by lush tropical vegetation and set on a white sandy beach this property is ideal for the great outdoor lovers.
