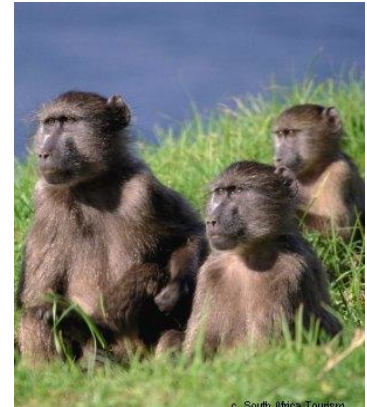


Cape Town Tour: Peninsula with Baboon Walk



Overview

This privately guided full day tour travels the Cape Peninsula to Africa's tip - from where a walk to the lighthouse affords staggering views across False Bay to where two oceans meet. The tour affords a privileged up-close encounter with a troop of baboons, for whom this rocky environment is home. Also included is a trip to the penguin colony at Simonstown and a drive along the stunning scenic route of Chapman's Peak Drive.

Outline

Leave the City along the Southern Peninsula to meet a qualified baboon monitor, for a guided encounter with a troop of Chacma baboons in their natural mountain environment. Your guide has studied these baboons for years, and will advise you on their habits as they eat, play and socialise.

From here, visit the historic naval village of Simonstown, stopping at Bounders Beach - home to a large colony of African Penguins.

After lunch at a local seafood restaurant, we drive down the coast into the Cape of Good Hope National Park - some species you may see here include Baboon and Cape Mountain Zebra. We make our way to the tip of the Peninsula at Cape Point - the south westernmost point of Africa.

Our route back takes us along Chapman's Peak Drive - 600m above the ocean and one of the world's most breathtaking coastal passes. From June to November, Southern Right Whales can be seen offshore from the road.
