

Cape Town Tour: Peninsula with Cycling



Overview

This privately guided full day tour travels the Cape Peninsula to Africa's tip - from where a walk to the lighthouse affords staggering views across False Bay to where two oceans meet. The tour takes in the scenery by bicycle ... Also included is a trip to the penguin colony at Simonstown and a drive along the stunning scenic route of Chapman's Peak Drive.

Outline

Depart Cape Town by vehicle to Boulders Beach near Simonstown to visit the African Penguin colony.

Kitted out with bikes, we cycle on down the coastal road to Miller's Point and Smitswinkel Bay (weather permitting) and continue into the Cape of Good Hope National Park, where we cycle - keeping an eye out for Bontebok and Cape Mountain Zebra. We make our way to the tip of the Peninsula at Cape Point - the south westernmost point of Africa and enjoy a gourmet picnic lunch at one of the beaches.

Our route back takes us along Chapman's Peak Drive - 600m above the ocean and one of the world's most breathtaking coastal passes. From June to November, Southern Right Whales can be seen offshore from the road.
