



## Cape Town Tour: Peninsula with Sea Kayaking to the Penguins



### Overview

This privately guided full day tour travels the Cape Peninsula to Africa's tip - from where a walk to the lighthouse affords staggering views across False Bay to where two oceans meet. Kayaking along the coastline is an easy paddle - and offers a different perspective on the coastline and its wildlife.

### Outline

Depart the City for Simonswotn to meet a sea-kayaking guide for a safety briefing and gear up for a few hours' easy paddling in twin kayaks along the False Bay coast. Your paddle takes you to Boulders Beach's colony of African Penguins - you view them from the ocean as they swim around this quaint cove.

After lunch at a local seafood restaurant, we drive down the coast into the Cape of Good Hope National Park - some species you may see here include Baboon and Cape Mountain Zebra. We make our way to the tip of the Peninsula at Cape Point - the southern westernmost point of Africa.

Our route back takes us along Chapman's Peak Drive - 600m above the ocean and one of the world's most breathtaking coastal passes. From June to November, Southern Right Whales can be seen offshore from the road.
