Immerse yourself in the vast and beautiful subarctic landscape on this adventure to witness Canada's dazzling aurora borealis. On a Subarctic Discovery: Churchill Northern Lights trip, enjoy heading away from the lights of town to exclusive viewing locations, such as Dan's Diner a remote culinary experience located on the frozen Churchill River beneath the northern lights. During the day, your small group will enjoy authentic winter experiences when you snowshoe through pristine landscapes, dog sled through the boreal forest and learn about local culture and history.

Located directly beneath the auroral oval, this remote community of 900 people is regarded as one of the best places on Earth to experience the dazzling aurora borealis. Imagine being able to step out onto the tundra and feel tiny against the never-ending sky, enveloping you in Mother Nature's most spectacular light show.

Accompanied by your own Interpretive Guide, this *Northern Lights* adventure offers a unique program in which travellers can fly direct to Churchill, Manitoba to experience the dancing skies and the incredible culture of Canada's North.

Day 1

ARRIVAL — You arrive into Winnipeg and check into your hotel close Winnipeg airport; This evening, you meet the rest of your group and enjoy a welcome dinner hosted by your trip guide. (MEALS: D)

Day 2

CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS

This morning, you take an early morning flight to Churchill; Upon arrival, you head out on a Churchill area tour, which includes a visit to the Polar Bear Holding facility and the Parks Canada visitors centre, which is full of local historical information on Churchill.

This evening, you journey by Tundra Buggy to Dan's Diner and experience regional cuisine in pop-up restaurant, complete with skylights and panoramic windows for the best Northern Lights viewing experience. culinary opportunities. After dinner, you head by Tundra Buggy to the Thanadelthur Lounge. Here you can view the Northern Lights by peering out of the panoramic windows or you can climb onto the rooftop observation desk for an unobstructed view of the Northern Lights, as they streak across the sky. Overnight at Churchill hotel. Meals: L, D

Day 3

DOG SLEDDING, SNOWSHOES AND NORTHERN LIGHTS

This morning, you join an exhilarating dog sledding experience. You will be hosted by a local expert, who will explain the significance of dog sledding to the community. After lunch you join a snowshoeing adventure through the Boreal Forest! This evening, you head out into the forest to a modern-style yurt, where you can photograph the Northern Lights once more, away from the lights of the town. Overnight at Churchill hotel. Meals: B, L, D

Day 4

LAST DAY IN CHURCHILL

This morning, you have some free time to explore the town of Churchill; being heading to the Itsanitaq Museum, which has a large collection of Inuit artifacts. This evening, you depart Churchill for your flight back to Winnipeg. Accommodation near the airport on return. Meals: B, L, D

DEPART

You depart Winnipeg for your onward flight.

GENERAL INFORMATION – PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ THE FOLLOWING

Passports: Please ensure these are valid for travel and that you are in possession of valid visas (if required see below). You are required to take out comprehensive travel insurance to safeguard against cancellation and curtailment, medical expenses, repatriation expenses, damage/theft/loss of personal baggage, money and personal belongings.

Visas: Not required for Canada for UK or EU nationals for stays of up to 90 days. An onward or return ticket is required, as well as sufficient funds and documents needed for further travel. Please note that visitors to Canada must have a MINIMUM of two blank/empty VISA pages in their passport each time entry is sought. Visitors to Canada with foreign passports who do not comply with these requirements will either be stopped from boarding their aircraft at their point of departure or risk deportation on arrival in Canada.

Health: All travellers should seek advice from their local GP or travel clinic for up-to-date advice on vaccinations and different malarial options. Travel insurance is part of the Terms and Conditions of your trip with Native Escapes it is essential that you purchase comprehensive travel insurance for your trip. Your insurance should be inclusive of full medical cover including costs of emergency repatriation, cancellation and travel delay.

Native Escapes complies with the UK Package & Travel Regulations 1992. Holidays with flights included are covered by the company's ATOL Bond (Air Travel Organisers' Licence) held by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA). This means that in the unfortunate event that our company should fail, the CAA will arrange any necessary repatriation and any refund of monies paid to Native Escapes in advance.
